Policies

Commitment to Suzuki Talent Education. All students and their families are required to commit to a full year of study. Regular attendance is essential. There will be no refund of tuition for student absence. However, if the teacher is absent or classes are cancelled due to inclement weather, a make-up lesson will be arranged. In the event of extenuating circumstances on the part of the student, make-up lessons may be offered as a courtesy by the teacher.

Family Responsibilities. Each family is responsible for providing the instrument, providing Suzuki recordings and music book, repairing instruments, and participating in fundraising activities

Fees

Registration. Each family is expected to pay a registration fee of \$10 per year. The fee is due with the fall application and tuition.

Tuition. Tuition is \$65 per month or \$325 for five months. Tuition is due at the time of application, which is one month prior to the first day of class of each semester.

Family Rates. When more than one child in a family enrolls, a reduced rate of \$15 will apply for each successive child, with the discount being applied to the rate of the last child. For example, cost for the first child is \$300; cost for the second child will be \$285; cost for the third child will be \$270, etc.

Lessons and other services

Tuition pays for at least 75 hours of fine arts activities each semester. This would include weekly private and group music lessons (Suzuki violin, cello or piano.) Music will include sight reading and theory. Participants will have access to visual and literary arts each semester.

Tuition also pays for:

- Planning and coordinating all programs and community presentations
- Some supplies and materials
- Management and supervision

Instrument Rental

A few violins are available for rent from Art for Life. Rentals are arranged by management. Students renting instruments from Art for Life shall demonstrate regularity of study and attendance. Instruments are rented at \$25 per semester or \$50 per year. Rental fee for cellos is \$30 per semester or \$60 per year.
