Policies

1) All families are required to commit to a full year of study with regular attendance. 2) Make-up lessons will be provided for extenuating circumstances on the part of the student/family. 3) Each family is responsible for providing the instrument, Suzuki recordings and music books, repairing instruments, and participating in fundraising activities. 4) Art for Life's Sake will be closed during inclement weather.

Fees

Each family is expected to pay a \$10 registration fee per year, due with the fall application and tuition. Tuition is \$65 per month or \$325 per semester, Aug-Dec (fall) and Jan-May (spring). Family discounts are available when more than one child in a family enrolls; e.g. a reduced rate of \$15 for each additional child.

Instrument Rental

A limited number of used and new instruments are available from Art for Life's Sake.

Services

Tuition partially pays for at least 75 hours of fine arts, personal and academic enrichment activities per semester. Additional services include supervision of on-going activities and community presentations, and some supplies and materials. Participants will also have access to literacy, vocabulary development, oratorical skills, visual arts, fitness, and drama.
